

The Replay Project: United States Football League Simulation



Overview:

The Replay Project is a weekly series of simulation-based reports that recreate and analyze games in the United States Football League (USFL). Each report is presented as a clickable PDF on our website, allowing fans and enthusiasts to explore game results, and standings, in a fun and engaging way.

Key Features:

- **Simulation-Based Results:** Every game is generated using a football simulation system, ensuring each matchup is unique and replayable.
- **Team Identification:** Teams are represented using their official colors and city names across uniforms. No official logos or trademarks are used on the uniforms. Team nicknames (e.g., “Breakers”) appear only in captions, headlines, or tables for clarity.
- **Weekly Reports:** Each PDF contains full results for that week, including scores, latest standings, and highlight commentary.
- **Interactive and Accessible:** PDFs are designed to be easy to navigate, with clickable sections for each week.

Purpose:

The series aims to provide fans with an engaging, analytical, and fun way to experience USFL football in a simulation format. Whether you enjoy tracking team performance, exploring game stats, or simply watching simulated matchups unfold, *The Replay Project* offers a weekly snapshot of football excitement — all in a safe, legal, and creative format.

Simulation Mechanics: Zermelo Values and Home Field Advantage

To generate realistic game results in the USFL simulation, each team is assigned a **Zermelo value**, which represents its relative strength in the league achieved during the 1983, '84, '85 and 2022, 2023, and UFL games between USFL teams only. These values are derived from historical performance.

- **Zermelo Values:**

Each team's Zermelo value is a number that quantifies its ability to win games. A higher value indicates a stronger team. When two teams face each other, the difference in their Zermelo values is used to calculate the probability of each team winning the matchup.

- **Home Field Advantage (HFA) Multiplier:**

To simulate the real-world impact of playing at home, each team has an HFA multiplier. This multiplier boosts a team's Zermelo value when it is playing at home. For example, if the league has an HFA multiplier of **1.5**, the team's effective Zermelo value is multiplied by 1.5 when hosting the game. This ensures that home games are significantly more challenging for visiting teams.

Example Calculation (simplified):

1. Team A Zermelo: 1.20 | Team B Zermelo: 1.00
2. Team A HFA at home: 1.5 → Effective Zermelo: $1.20 \times 1.5 = 1.80$
3. Probability of Team A winning: $1.80 \div (1.80 + 1.00) \approx 0.64$ (64%)

This system allows every game to have a mathematically grounded outcome while still allowing for upsets, close contests, and variability throughout the season.

Playoffs Structure

The simulation concludes with a **postseason playoff** to determine the league champion. The USFL is divided into **Eastern** and **Western** conferences, and playoff spots are awarded based on regular-season performance that mirrors the divisional alignment in 1984.

Seeding

- The **division winners** in each conference earn the **#1 and #2 seeds**, reflecting their top performance within their divisions.
- The **next two best teams** in each conference, based on overall records, qualify as **wildcard teams** and are seeded #3 and #4.

Home Field Advantage (HFA)

- The **HFA multiplier** is applied throughout the playoffs. The **higher-seeded team hosts the game**, increasing their effective Zermelo value and giving them a higher probability of winning the matchup.
- **Exception – Championship Game (Firecracker Bowl):**
 - The championship game is held on the evening of **July 4th**, and its **location is determined during the season**.
 - **HFA is not applied**, even if the game is at one of the participating team's stadium. This assumes that **both teams have an equal number of fans rooting for them**, removing any home-field advantage and ensuring a neutral-field simulation.

Playoff Format

- Each conference features **four teams** (two division winners + two wildcards), for a total of **eight playoff teams** league-wide.
- Matchups are arranged so that the **#1 seed plays the #4 seed** and the **#2 seed plays the #3 seed** within each conference.
- Winners of the conference semifinals advance to the **conference championship game**, and the two conference champions meet in the **Firecracker Bowl**, the league championship.

This format ensures that **regular-season success is rewarded**, higher seeds benefit from **home-field advantage** throughout the playoffs, and the championship game is simulated fairly on a neutral-field basis.
